The GT's smooth delivery can be attributed to a silent chain-driven single-overhead cam, coupled with hydraulically adjusted roller finger followers to maintain optimal valve lash adjustment.




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Aluminum twin-piston front calipers reduce unsprung weight and enhance brake pedal feel.



The 3.8-liter V6 splitport engine makes 190 horsepower at 5,250 rpm, and produces 220 lbs.-ft. of torque at 2,750 rpm. You can see that torque and horsepower curves are relatively "flat." This demonstrates smooth, consistent acceleration throughout the rpm range.



The deep-skirt modular 4.6-liter single-overhead-cam V8 delivers 260 horsepower at 5,000 rpm and 302 lbs.-ft. of torque at 4,000 rpm. It's the engine that likes to perform at higher rpm. Note all the torque you get at the higher end.

Mustang is a balanced driving experience. **All-Speed Traction** Control,* specially tuned suspension, and aluminum twin-piston front brake calipers offer a surefooted performance setup.

There are two Mustang engines. The advanced modular 4.6-liter V8, which benefits from high lift, long-duration cams, big valves and wide intake ports. And the smooth 3.8-liter V6, which gets its power from split-port induction, easy-flow cylinder heads, and low-friction piston coatings.





